The regular meeting of the Franklin Town Board was called to order at 7:30 PM by Don Smith, Supervisor. Present were Don Smith, Dwight Bruno, Garret Sitts, Teddie Storey, Paul Warner and Jamie Archibald.

Also present were Brian Brock, Roberta Hudson, Cameron Sitts, Amber Gray, Terry Huyck, Georgia Hilmer and Craig Brock.

The minutes were read from the August 6, 2024 meeting. Teddie Storey made the motion to approve the minutes as amended. Dwight Bruno seconded the motion. All present agreed.

Garret reported that KECC is pretty quiet. They are painting the dugouts. Also, a new parking lot was discussed. They decided to roll over their CD's.

Jamie reported that that speed reduction was approved by the State on Case Hill Road. It is now 45 MPH for the whole road and drops to 30 MPH in Village.

6 miles of chip sealing has been completed. They also did a lot of clean up from storms.

Planning Board hasn't had their meeting yet this month.

The Town Clerk proposed to be able to take credit/debit card for any clerk transactions and taxes. The customer will pay the fee. Teddie made the motion to approve the clerk taking credit/debit cards and echecks. Garret seconded the motion. All present agreed.

Brian Brock questioned whether the town had insurance to cover if anyone got sick from drinking the water in Treadwell. That will be looked into to be sure.

Amber Gray asked Jamie Archibald to look at the storm drain near her house as it doesn't seem to be working correctly.

Garret Sitts made the motion at 7:45 PM to go into executive session for contractual issues. Teddie Storey seconded the motion. All present agreed.

At 8:40 the board returned from executive session.

Teddie Storey made the motion for the code enforcer to be able to send certified letters for short term rental properties. Garret Sitts seconded the motion. All present agreed.
