

September 6, 2022

The regular meeting of the Franklin Town Board was called to order at 7:34 PM by Jeff Taggart, Supervisor. Present were Jeff Taggart, Dwight Bruno, Donnie Smith, Heather Ross, Paul Warner and Mark Laing

Also present were Doug Weber, Sara Andros, Carla Nordstrom, Mike Wallace, Brian Brock, Robert Ackerman, Andy Bobrow, Giuliana Longo, Carol Jensen, Eric Huneke and Craig Brock.

The minutes were read from the August 2, 2022 meeting. Donnie Smith made the motion to approve minutes as amended. Dwight Bruno seconded the motion. All present agreed.

Donnie Smith reported for the Franklin Kellogg Trust. The lines have been done on the courts. Finances are stable. They are boxing things up to move. Any help would be welcome.

Heather Ross reported for the Rec Commission. August 31 was Amanda Groff's last day. The next meeting is September 13. She will have more information after that.

Doug Weber said Code Enforcement is busy but there was nothing out of the ordinary.

Jeff read a Resolution to have the cannabis dispensaries and on site consumption establishments on the November 2022 ballot. Donnie Smith made the motion to approve Resolution. Heather Ross seconded the motion. All present agreed.

Bills from the Treadwell Water District were presented totaling \$18,000.00 for repairs and upgrades . There was a \$570.00 fine for reports being submitted late which will be paid from water fund. They will start looking for and applying for grants to help pay for upgrades and new meters.

Giuliana Longo spoke about the Association on Thoroughbred Rd. The board told her there isn't anything the Town can do for them. They should obtain legal help.

Mark Laing reported that the new truck is in Monticello.

They will be paving Gay Brook, Grange Hall, Blue School and Swart Hollow weather permitting.

Carla Nordstrom brought a concern of ATV's and dirt bikes using the road to the old landfill and riding at the Town property. The board said there are posted signs up and they will try to keep the gates closed.

Vouchers 2022-334 – 2022-386 were presented for payment.

Dwight Bruno made the motion to go into executive session at 9:00 PM for legal and personnel issues.

The board returned from executive session at 9:50 PM and with nothing further to come before the board, the meeting was adjourned.
