Planning board had a boundary line adjustment. They also had discussions on the proposed campground on Oak Hill and the Solar Moratorium.

There was an update from Cedarwood Engineering. It included a summary of work that is to be done.

Don Smith made the motion to pay the bills until the end of the year. Heather Ross seconded the motion. All present agreed.

Jamie Archibald reported that all the radios have all been installed and are working well.

The truck is getting the new box installed.

They are getting quotes for a generator. Chad Trimbell from Trimbell Electric is working on this.

All of equipment sold at auction has been picked up except one. There was only one of the low bids that had a counter offer that was accepted. The rest will be relisted at a later date.

The Town is working with NYSEG cleaning up some trees that are out of NYSEG's right of way.

A resident of Epps Road was questioning why the Town had stopped plowing to her house. Jamie will meet with her at her property to see if they can figure something out.

Vouchers #2023-469 – 2023-514 were presented for payment.

Heather made the motion to go to executive session for personnel. Donnie Smith seconded the motion. All present agreed.

The board returned from executive session and the meeting was adjourned.
